

## Right to Eject/Refuse Entry to CCISD Property

In 2017, <u>Texas Senate Bill 1553</u> ammended <u>Section 37.105</u> of Texas Education Code to allow a school administrator, school resource officer, or the district peace officer to eject an individual from, or refuse entry to, property subject to the district's control if the individual refuses to leave peaceably upon request and the person: a) poses a substantial risk of harm to any person; or b) behaves in a manner inappropriate for the school setting, an administrator or officer issues the individual a verbal warning, and the individual persists in the behavior.

Appeals regarding refusal of entry or ejection from district property may be filed in accordance with <u>FNG(LOCAL)</u> or <u>GF(LOCAL)</u> as appropriate. The person must be able to present <u>his or her appeal</u> to the board in person within 90 days of filing the appeal.
